Notification for 1st year, 2nd year and 3rd year BTech students [Subject to no circular from the MHRD to the contrary]

On approval of the competent authority it is being notified that there will be no end term examination. Consequence to that-

1. Assessment of theory papers for the 2nd and 3rd year students will be done with the following pattern:

- 60% weightage for the end-semester component on previous performance:
(30% weightage on current CGPA + 30% weightage on best SGPA obtained so far)
- 25% weightage on mid-term examination
- 15% weightage on continuous assessment of performance done prior to lockdown.

2. Assessment of sessional/laboratory papers for the 2nd and 3rd year students will be done through assessment of performance in sessional/laboratory classes held before lockdown.

3. Considering that only one semester availed by the 1st year students, which makes their CGPA and SGPA the same, the basis of the evaluation for the theory courses will be as follows.

- 60% weightage will be given on the mid-term performance and will be computed as:
(Actual marks obtained in the mid-term examination, recalculated out of 45 marks) +15.
For example, if a student has obtained 'X' in mid semester out of 25, the calculation will be:
 $((X/25)*45) +15$
- 25% weightage on 1st semester SGPA.
- 15% weightage on continuous assessment of performance done prior to lockdown.

4. Assessment of sessional/laboratory papers for the 1st year students will be done based on continuous assessment of performance in sessional/laboratory classes held before lockdown.

5. If any student is not satisfied with the result thus calculated (except for computation errors, which may be pointed out to the concerned teachers within a week of publication of results), he/she may apply for improvement and may exercise the option of foregoing this result and appear for regular method of examination, which may be held only after the pandemic situation normalizes. In such a situation the student has to appear in all the theory subjects in that semester on reopening of the Institute and the result thus obtained will replace the earlier one with no option of reverting back. The option should be exercised within ten (10) days of publication of results.

6. The backlog paper examinations will be conducted separately afterward and will be notified accordingly. Such students are advised to visit the institute website regularly.

7. The expected date of publication of the result on the basis cited above is last week of July 2020.

8. The students will be called in the campus with sufficient notice period, when the situation will become favourable and safe.

9. The 3rd year students can avail the internship opportunity till the end of the August 2020. All the students are also advised to engage themselves on online learning and internship, if available, during this period.
