- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempte the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offethe bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Categoroucts to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC t submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bubids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 4. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Po Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible purchase preference. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted r The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases when option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery dur up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.
