	Considering the pace of work of CPWD, the scheduled completion of the project may be considered as 31.12.2023.

In this regard, the tentative estimated amount of Rs. <b>2,40,53,061/</b> - (Rupees Two Crore Forty Lakhs Fifty-Three Thousand and Sixty-One only) for the upgradation of OFC backbone of the residential area is required. <b>(Annexures 42.5&amp; 42.6)</b>



The OFC layout which is existing and working now is laid in 2007. During this period of 15 years there has been a great deal of wear & tear due to massive construction works in the campus at different points. The continuity of the fiber has been managed through splicing Joined) at multiple points, and now over the years these are causing an abundant data loss and erratic behavior in network connectivity.

Moreover, a huge scaled up in number of user and also in the number of academic related buildings, staff residence area, gadgets with internet dependency, online classes & online seminars going on depending on the internet system, has come up in the campus during this period.

Though to meet the growing demand of internet facilities we have already got 10G compatible core switch, high end servers, GPU servers, VPN switch etc. in the server room which has high requirement over the campus, but due to the wear & tear in the OFC the smooth connectivity to these resources are disturbed.

All the hostels are to be connected with dedicated network by BSNL. These tasks have given to the BSNL already and are under process.

Academic I Administration part of the campus are already being upgraded be CPWD/Other companies. But the residential area is still going on with the same OFC back bone since its laid.

So, to cater this mammoth demand and dependency on the network we are compelled to make new O.F.C layout throughout the residential area without which it can collapse at any given point of time.

The external expert Prof. Biplab K. Sikdar, IIEST Shibpur has analyzed and verified OFC layout for the quarters (campus) area.

We have provided the tentative estimation of Rs. 2,40,53,061/- (Rupees Two Crore Forty Lakhs Fifty-Three Thousand and Sixty-One only) for the upgradation of OFC backbone of the residential area which has to be done to get the uninterrupted high speed network facility throughout the campus.
