The Chairman welcomed the Senate members to the meeting and requested Secretary, Senate to present the agenda of the 62nd Senate meeting.

Item No. 62.1 **Confirmation of the Minutes of the 61st Senate Meeting**

The minutes of the 61st Senate meeting were confirmed by the Senate.

Item No. 62.2 **Action Taken Report**

The Senate of the Institute noted the Action Taken Report with satisfaction.

In regard to Item No. 61.19.2 (To name the Central Library after a distinguished personality), the Senate decided to invite suitable suggestions from the Senate Members through circulation of mail.

Item No. 62.3 **To discuss issues pertaining to the 17th Convocation.**

- In keeping with the initiative of the Hon'ble Chairperson in deciding on the date and Chief Guest for the 17th Convocation, the Senate decided to conduct the 17th Convocation on Saturday, January 8, 2022 where Padma Bibhusan Dr. Anil Kakodkar would be gracing the occasion as the Chief Guest.
- The Senate further decided to invite Shri K. Sanjay Murthy, Secretary, Higher Education, Ministry of Education / Dr. Sekhar Mande, Secretary, Department of Scientific and Industrial Research / Mr. Purnendu Chatterjee, Founder & Chairman, TCG Group / in the capacity of the Guest of Honour.
- The Senate also decided in favour of a hybrid mode of conduction of the 17th Convocation where the medal awardees and other distinguished awardees would be conferred the medals physically while other degree awards would be conducted in an offline mode.

- The Senate, in keeping with the suggestion of the Hon'ble Chairperson, decided to suitably include photographs of the degree recipients in the Degree Certificate through embedding the individual photographs within the QR code to be printed in the Degree Certificate.
- The Senate further approved the formats for the UG, PG and PhD certificates.

Item No. 62.4

To consider the resolutions of UGAC meetings.

The Senate recommended the list of UG degree awardees and Gold Medal awardees in the 17th Convocation, and approved/ratified the other resolutions of the UGAC meetings held on 01.10.2021 and 01.11.2021 with the following addendum.

UGAC meeting on 01/10/2021

- *Item No. # 8:* The recommended norms for minimum number of students in an elective subject in the UG and PG courses were approved as 5 and 2 respectively.
- *Item No. # 9:* The recommended modalities for six-month Industry Internship of the B. Tech. students were approved by the Senate. The same shall be applicable for the final year PG students going for one year internship.
- *Item No. # 10b:* The Slot-based Class Schedule was approved by the Senate.

UGAC meeting on 01/11/2021

- *Item No. # 4:* The Senate approved the introduction of the compulsory course "XXC01: The Constitution of India and Civic Norms (L-T-P: 1-0-0)" for all the UG-2nd semester students. The revised curriculum shall be applicable for the students admitted in AY2021-22 onwards. A committee with the following members will prepare the syllabus:

HOD, DMS – Convener

HOD, HSS – Member

Dr. Maidul Islam, Asst. Prof., CSSS Kolkata – Domain expert

Dr. Islam will be requested to deliver some content and attempt should be made to record the lectures at the CDL of the Institute.

Initially, the Department of Management Studies shall coordinate the delivery and evaluation process for two academic years.

- *Item No. # 6b:* The Senate decided that the academic calendar shall be prepared for first semester UG students, considering the classes will be conducted in on-line mode and excluding hands-on laboratory schedule.

Item No. 62.5

To consider the resolutions of PGAC meetings.

The Senate noted with concern that the admission to a number of PG programs is low, and the departments were requested to look into the matter carefully and take urgent remedial measures. The Senate

recommended the list of PG degree awardees and Gold Medal awardees in the 17th Convocation, and approved/ratified the other resolutions of the PGAC meetings held on 01.10.2021 and 01.11.2021 with the following addendum.

PGAC meeting on 01/10/2021

- *Item No. # 6:* Revision in the M. Tech. curriculum and syllabus for Thermal Engineering, as recommended by the PGAC, was approved by the Senate.
- *Item No. # 7:* Revision in the curriculum and syllabus for the Dual Degree Program in Biotechnology, as recommended by the UGAC & PGAC, was approved by the Senate. The revision shall be applicable for the students admitted in 2019-20 onwards.
- *Item No. # 10a:* The recommended modalities related to conversion from M. Tech. (Regular) to (Off-campus) were approved by the Senate.

Item No. 62.6

To consider the resolutions of RAC meetings.

- The Senate recommended the list of PhD degree awardees in the 17th Convocation, and approved/ratified the other resolutions of the RAC meetings held on 24.09.2021 and 02.11.2021 with the following addendum:

Award of 36 PhD degrees (**Annexure I**) was recommended by the Senate, and registration of 18 candidates for the PhD program (**Annexure II**) was approved by the Senate.

RAC meeting on 02.11.2021

- *Item # 5:* Senate decided that Som Subhra Dutta (19BT1111), a UGC-sponsored PhD research scholar, should complete the PhD registration process prior to his release. He should take withdrawal and if necessary include a co-supervisor.
- *Item # 7:* Pullabhatla Srikanth (20REE006) was permitted by the Senate for an early pre-submission seminar and submission of the PhD thesis as a special case. This cannot, however, be cited in future as a precedence.
- *Item # 11:* The Senate resolved that only the caution deposit should be refunded to the individual scholar after due compliance with the extant regulations. Refund of any other fee shall not be admissible.

Item No. 62.7

To consider the re-introduction of self-sponsored PhD program.

- The Senate recommended the re-introduction of self-sponsored PhD program (Category K) as proposed by the Senate-constituted committee and recommended by the RAC.
- The Senate recommended that the tuition fee for such candidates shall be Rs. 20000/- per semester.
- The senate further resolved to offer teaching assignments to the willing self-sponsored PhD candidates and to offer certificates to such candidates from the competent authority.

- In addition, the Senate resolved to merge the Category L, proposed by the committee, with Category H, which is renamed henceforth as **Category-H: Professional Research Scholars from Industries**. It was also resolved that the applicants in Category H may furnish either No-objection certificate or Sponsorship certificate from the employer during the admission process.

Item No. 62.8 To consider relaxation in the minimum total credit requirement for the PhD students who have completed their Master's degree five or more years ago.

The Senate resolved that the minimum total credit requirement for the PhD students admitted in the Academic Session ODD SEM 2021-22 onwards with M. Tech. degree or equivalent shall be 9 credits in addition to the Research Methodology course. The requirement for the students having other degrees shall remain unaltered at 16 in addition to Research Methodology.

Modified Clause 6.2.2 (i) of PhD Regulations may be read as:

6.2.2 The DSC will prescribe additional courses as: i) Scholars with M. Tech./equivalent degree : Minimum 9 credits plus Research Methodology.

Item No. 62.9 To consider equivalence of filing of a patent with one publication in a SCI/ SSCI/ AHCI/ Non-paid Scopus/ Web of Science journal.

The item was deferred due to the lack of convergence in the opinion of the members.

Item No. 62.10 To consider admission of students to the Collaborative/Joint PhD programs in both semesters.

The Senate approved the admission of students to the Collaborative/Joint PhD programs in both odd and even semesters and it is resolved to create a new category L: Regular Research Scholar under Collaborative/Joint PhD programs. Admission of research scholar under Collaborative/Joint PhD programs (Category L) shall be made as per laid down terms and conditions in MoU with respective institute / organization.


Item No. 62.11 To consider conduction of online viva as a component of the online end-term examinations in the academic year 2021-22.

The Senate resolved that online viva, up to 20 marks, may be conducted as a component of the online end-term examinations in the academic year 2021-22 as per the discretion of the individual course teacher. The students should be informed well in advance by the course teacher of the mode and the time of viva-voce.

Item No. 62.12 Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

- 62.12.1 The Senate recommended the signing of MoUs between NIT Durgapur and (i) Central Board of Irrigation and Power; (ii) National Highways Authority of India; (iii) National Brain Research Centre, Manesar; (iv) Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Biotechnology, Thiruvananthapuram and (v) Central Manufacturing Technology Institute, Bengaluru. The Senate further recommended the renewal of MoU between NIT Durgapur and the National Institute of Science & Technology, Muscat, Oman.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
