The Chairman welcomed the Senate members to the meeting and requested Secretary, Senate to present the agenda of the 63rd Senate meeting.

Item No. 63.1 Academic Calendar of AY 2021-22

The Senate approved the academic calendar for the academic year 2021-22 as presented by Dean (Academic Courses):

- (a) Even Semester, other than first year UG (Annexure 1)
- (b) Odd & Even Semesters, first year UG (Annexure 2)

The Senate further resolved that

- All activities of Odd semester for the first year UG will be held in the on-line mode.
- Academic activities of even semester for all students will be held on off-line mode. However, for the first year and final year UG students, theory subjects may be taught in the on-line mode for the first few weeks of the even semester.
- Laboratory classes of the students will be conducted in physical mode once they return to the campus. This decision was made in view of the limited infrastructure existing in the hostels.
- All examinations of even semester will be conducted in the campus as was the practice in the pre-COVID period.

Item No. 63.2 Mechanism for the return of the students in the Institute Campus

The Senate approved the schedule of return of the students in phase-wise manner as was proposed by the Chief Warden. It was decided that the schedule might be altered depending on the situation and Government notifications related to COVID-19.

In this regard, the Senate further decided the following:

- Most of the accommodation in hostels will be provided on a shared basis.
- A medical team will visit the hostel weekly for the general check-up of the students in addition to the medical facilities provided by the Institute Medical Unit.
- The students should bring a consent for attending offline classes from their respective parents/guardians.
- Institute will arrange for the vaccination of students for COVID 19, if necessary.

- Movement of students outside the campus may be restricted and to ensure proper adherence to the restrictions, a circular citing all details of hostel return, COVID norms to be followed, academic related matters will be issued by Dean (Academic Courses), Dean (Students Welfare) and Chief Warden taking feedback from SMO and other stakeholders of the Institute.
- The Senate resolved to conduct the classes in New Academic Building as the classrooms are bigger and can accommodate more students. The Senate opined that classrooms should be sanitized after each class. Morning and Day shift (1st year & 3rd year during the morning session and 2nd & 4th year during the at day session) was proposed for adherence to social distancing measures.
- It was also decided to marginally reduce the class duration with a 5 minute breather between each class.
- It was also decided that the faculty members may share their teaching materials with students who are not willing to attend the offline class. However, the class tests and examinations shall be held in the offline mode.

Item No. 63.3 Any other item

63.3.1 The Senate recommended the signing of MoUs between NIT Durgapur and

- National Jute Board, a Statutory Body, Ministry of Textile, GOl, Kolkata for two projects being supported by them.
