1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issues.

- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exerprovided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attacher</u> <u>categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)

Buyer is duty bound to reply to representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
