Final Progress Report of TEQIP III

NIT Durgapur got selected as one of the Mentor Institutes under TEQIP III in 2017-18 for mentoring two Institutes: i) Dumka Engineering College, Dumka, Jharkhand and ii) NIT Nagaland and was allocated a total project life allocation of Rs. 7 Crore under TEQIP III plus Rs. 4 Crore additional for creation of a Centre of Excellence (COE) in Advanced Materials for improvement in quality of technical education through infrastructure development and different academic activities. The life-time of the project was till March 31, 2021. However, it was further extended to September 2021 for some of the specific activities and fund was allocated some activities of some of the particular Institution, in which .NIT Durgapur was not included.

Accordingly, the Institute has achieved to fulfil its action plan for utilizing the funds allocated by NPIU under different heads of account. Finally, we have spent about 10.51 crores (Ten crores fifty-one lakhs) till March 31, 2021. A balance amount of about 49 lakhs was earmarked for procurement of equipment, etc. but this was not permitted for execution within extended the timeline as it was difficult to adhere to the revised guidelines of procurement within a short period. The significant expenditures were made on procurement (Rs. 4.4 Crore), improvement in students learning (around Rs. 39 Lakh), graduates employability (Rs. 8.33 Lakh), assistantship to students (around Rs.1.97 Crore), industry-Institute Interaction (around Rs. 16 Lakh), faculty/staff development and motivation (Rs. 76.3 Lakh), research and development (Rs. 1.53 Crore), reforms and governance (Rs., 46.7 Lakh), operation & maintenance of equipment (Rs. 19.7 Lakh) and office expenses (around Rs. 16.5 Lakh).

Third performance audit of TEQIP III was completed during 17-19 February, 2021 in virtual mode by Prof. Ravindra Gudi, Professor of Chemical Engineering, IIT Bombay and the Institute has performed very successfully with a score of 1.12 while 1.0 indicates the best performance.
