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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
3. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of multiple bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated on-line through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be a manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Required documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. The Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1 + 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference / price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer to the Order No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

Special terms and conditions-Version:1 effective from 02-01-2023 for category AC Static Watthour Meter Energy Meter (V2) as per IS 13779

1. In addition to the general terms and conditions of the GeM, the following are the special T&C
 - I. All Electronic Meters shall meet the latest requirements of Central Electricity Authority (Installation & Operation of meters) Regulations.
 - II. Meters shall be provided with the following anti-tampering features:
 - i. The meter shall not get damaged or rendered non-functional and shall operate accurately even if phase and neutral are interchanged. LED or LCD indication shall be provided on the meter where such tampering occurs for indication purposes.
 - ii. The meter shall register energy even when the return path of the load current is not terminated at the meter and in such a case the circuit shall be completed through the earth. In the case of metal bodies, the earth terminal shall be brought out and provided on the outside of the case.
 - iii. The meter shall operate accurately even when incoming mains is connected to outgoing terminals and the load is connected to incoming terminals. LED or LCD indication shall be provided on the meter wherever such tampering occurs.
 - iv. Three Phase meters shall have anti-tampering features like Phase sequence reversal, current reversal, missing potential, and missing neutral.
 - v. In the case of a 3-phase/4 wire system, the meter shall keep working even in the presence of 3 wires i.e. even in the absence of neutral and any one phase or any two phases.
 - vi. In the case of whole current meters and LV-CT-operated meters, the meter shall be capable of registering energy correctly even if input and output terminals are interchanged.
 - vii. The registration must occur whether the input phase or neutral wire is connected properly or the wires are interchanged at the input terminals.
 - viii. The meter shall be factory calibrated and shall be sealed suitably before dispatch.
 - ix. Neutral missing feature: Meter will register energy even if neutral is disconnected from both ends and the load is earthed in a single phase.
 - III. The meter shall be immune to external influences concerning parameters covered in IS:13779 with the amendments.
 - IV. All the three-phase meters shall have data storage capacity for at least 35 days in non-volatile memory.
 - V. The meter shall have downloading facilities for metered data through Common Meter Reading Instrument (CMRI).
 - VI. The terminal block, terminal cover, and meter case shall ensure reasonable safety against the spread of fire.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions/क्रेता द्वारा जोड़ी गई बिड की विशेष शर्तें

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase or decrease the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rate. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where the option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

1. Bidders are advised to provide the actual product that mentioned in the additional specification section strictly.
2. Supply of "**3 Phase 4 Wire LCD AC Static Watt-hour Meter**" will be done at the **Maintenance Section, NIT Durgapur.**
3. The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
4. The quoted price for Delivery should be including all charges and Taxes.
5. Payment will be made only after delivery and training (if required) of personnel. Payment in settlement of the bills will be subject to the deductions of income tax/GST at applicable rates under TDS.

6. Forms of EMD and PBG (If applicable):

Bidder should submit the EMD as specified in the tender. The EMD to be transferred ON-LINE only, receipt should be posted / couriered / deposit in person to the Tender Inviting Authority, within bid submission due date and time as indicated in the tender. Scanned copy of the instrument should be uploaded as part of the offer. Any falsification/ suppression of information would lead to the cancellation of contract with forfeiture of Bank guarantee. Payment process would be as per institute rules.

7. BIDDER/OEM must have Dedicated/toll Free. Telephone No. for Service Support.
8. Bidder/OEM must submit 1year Warranty Certificate.
9. Damage, manufacturing defective product must be replaced without freight or any additional charges.
10. Suitable penalty charges will be imposed in the case of delay of delivery of the said items.
11. Bidders shall not have a conflict of interest. Any bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.
12. Non-compliance of the said specification is subjected to disqualification of bid.
13. Bidder must upload the GEM bid document signed and stamped as read and acceptance of all the terms and condition and specification mentioned in the bid documents.

14. To be eligible to bid, the Bidders must ensure compliance to the following, failing which they shall not be eligible:

Restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of GFR 2017: Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India

15. Bidder must be able to provide purchase order/installation certificate at any CFTI/SFTI or GoI Organizations.

16. In case of any dispute The jurisdiction of the court will be Durgapur.

17. NIT Durgapur reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.

18. All other terms and conditions are follows as per the GFR-17 Purchase rules and its Amendments.

Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attache categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference section of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details

Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
