Item No. 6.4 **To consider Report on Ph.D. thesis submitted by Sri Ranjan Choudhury under the guidance of Dr. P. P. Sengupta, Professor of Humanities and Dr. S.C. Sikdar, Ex-Prof. of Maths. Depts.**

Resolved that Syllabus and Curriculum as prepared by the DAC, ECE for M.Tech. in Tele communication Engineering be approved.

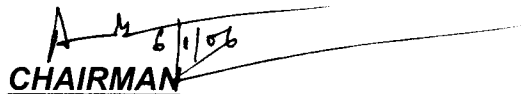
Any other Item No. 2 To consider Calendar for the Academic session 2005 – 2006.
