On the basis of the proposal submitted by the IIIT Division of the Ministry for extension in tenure of existing Chairperson, Board of Governors (BoGs), the Office of the Hon, ble Visitor of the Central Higher Education Institutions (President's Secretariat) has requested to all Directors of NITs and IIEST-Shibpur to place the following observations before their respective Board of Governors for passing a suitable resolution for amendment the clause 17 (15) of Statutes of NITs, IIEST-Shibpur to prevent existing overlap between responsibilities of Director and Chairperson, Board of Governors (BoGs) and to include a clause with respect to extending the tenure of the Chairperson, BoG.

The observations of IIIT Division:

- 1. To revisit their proposal in view of the provisions contained in clause 16 (15) of First Statutes if IIITs of the IIIT Act, 2014.
- 2. In order to have a clear distinction between the responsibilities of Director and Chairperson and to prevent any overlap, the Ministry is requested to take appropriate action to amend the Statutes, if Deemed necessary.

I am directed to inform that the Office of the Hon'ble Visitor of the Central Higher Education Institutions (President's Secretariat) in one of the proposal submitted by the IIIT Division of the Ministry for extension in tenure of existing Chairperson, BoGs, has returned the proposal with the following observations:-

- (i) To revisit their proposal in view of the provisions contained in clause 16 (15) of the First Statutes of IIITs of the IIIT Act, 2014;
- (ii) In order to have a clear distinction between the responsibilities of Director and Chairperson and to prevent any overlap, the Ministry is requested to take appropriate action to amend the Statutes, if deemed necessary.
- 2. The instructions received from the President's Secretariat in case of IIITs have also been brought to the notice of the NITs Division as the statutory provisions in case of 30 NITs, IIEST-Shibpur and NIT, Andhra Pradesh are identical to that of the provisions contained in the Statutes of IIITs. The instructions received from the Office of the Visitor of CHEIs necessitates that the existing clause 17 (15) of the Statutes of NITs, IIEST-Shibpur and NIT-Andhra Pradesh, respectively, may be amended to prevent existing overlap between the responsibilities of Director and Chairperson of BoG and to include a clause with respect to extending the tenure of the Chairperson, BoG.
- 3. As per provisions under Section 26 (2) of the NITSER Act, 2007, the Board of Governors of NITs & IIEST-Shibpur may, from time to time, make new or additional Statutes or may amend or repeal the existing Statutes. Accordingly, the Directors of the NITs and IIEST, Shibpur are requested to place the observations received from the President's Secretariat before the Board of Governors of their Institute for passing a suitable resolution for amending clause 17 (15) of the Statutes of NITs, IIEST-Shibpur.

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India & National Institute of Technology Durgapur for 2024-25 in pursuance of the Rule 229(xi) of the GFR, 2017.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is entered into at New Delhi on this May of April, 2024 between Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India, Shastri Bhawan, Rajendra Prasad Road, New Delhi-110011 (hereinafter referred to as MoE)

And

The National Institute of Technology Durgapur (hereinafter referred to as the Institute) having its Headquarter at Durgapur and represented by its Director (hereinafter referred to as the Institute) which term and expression shall mean and include, unless repugnant to the context, its successors, assignees, administrators of the Institute.

WHEREAS

- 1. This MoU is executed in terms of Rule 229 (xi) of the General Financial Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as GFR, 2017) and the subsequent instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, (hereinafter referred to as MoF) with the objective of improving efficiency of the expenditure, making the action plan outcome oriented, maintaining financial discipline and measuring performance of the Institution on key parameters against the targets set so as to improve its performance.
- 2. The Institute has the pre-defined Vision, Mission and Objectives as outlined hereunder:-

(A) Vision:

To impart quality technical education and focus on research and innovation to cater to the need of the country

(B) Mission:

 To impart quality technical and scientific education and produce engineers, technologists, scientists and citizens who will contribute meaningfully to the growth and development of the country and excel in various

disciplines of knowledge.

2. To initiate the students to research-oriented teachinglearning environment in the Institute with a focus on excellence and innovation.

(C) Objectives:

- 1. To choose a fully inclusive growth path, carrying all the students, the faculty members and the staff with it
- 2. To focus on excellence and innovation
- 3. To attribute greater emphasis on post graduate education and research
- 4. To focus on inter-disciplinary research and academics
- 5. To encourage the faculty to take up more sponsored projects and consultancy and increase internal resource generation
- 6. To become a major player in the endeavour to make India a most favoured destination for international students and global research
- 7. To collaborate with premier universities and organizations across the globe on research
- 8. To initiate undergraduate students to research very early in pursuance of the "catch them young" policy
- 9. To restructure the academic departments and to set up schools and centres to offer interdisciplinary post graduate and doctoral programmes
- 10. To reorient/ restructure the academic programmes in keeping with the developments and market forces
- 11. To revise the curricula and syllabi regularly following NEP 2020 guidelines
- 12. To initiate greater interaction with industries in the areas of collaborative projects and programmes, exchange of resource persons and training of students
- 13. To remain committed to responsibilities towards providing services to community, to make the people aware of crucial socio-technical and socio-economic problems and offer technical solutions in rural, urban and agricultural sectors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties here to express their common understanding as under:

(A) Ministry of Education shall

- (i) Provide financial support to the Institute to meet its recurring and non-recurring liabilities in such manner and on such conditions as prescribed by the Government of India (hereinafter referred to as GoI) from time to time,
- (ii) Help raise other resources, including loan from HEFA for expansion of infrastructural facilities, which have a direct bearing on the performance of the Institute as committed in this MOU.
- (iii) Provide guidance and advice in administrative, financial, legal and such other matters as the Institute may require in fulfilling its mandate.
- (iv) Provide support in obtaining necessary clearances and approvals, as and when required, from various Ministries, Departments, and Agencies of the Central/State Governments.
- (v) Provide support in resolving any dispute with any other authority of the Central/State Government or a private party, as and when required.

(B) THE INSTITUTE shall comply with:

- (i) Without prejudice to what has been stipulated in the National Institutes of Technology, Science Education and Research Act, 2007, as amended from time to time and the Statutes framed thereunder, the institute is expected to recover user charges at rates not lower than cost recovery norms.
- (ii) Specific provisions as contained in the OM No.1/1/2016-EIIIA dated 13.01.2017 in relation to revision of pay scales in accordance with the recommendations of the 7th CPC and any other instruction issued by MoE from time to time on issues pertaining to the Institute.
- (iii) The provisions of the GFR, 2017, including the instructions on financial advice for autonomous bodies, as mentioned in Rule 229(viii) and those concerning release of grants-in-aid, submission of audited accounts, performance report etc.
- (iv) Guidelines issued by the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) in matters of vigilance and disciplinary proceedings etc.



- (v) Uniform accounting procedure in accordance with the guidelines issued by MoF.
- (vi) Provisions of the National Institutes of Technology, Science Education and Research Act, 2007, the Statutes framed thereunder and the instructions issued by M. Edu. from time to time with regard, inter-alia, to creation of posts and framing of Recruitment Rules.

(C) THE INSTITUTE shall also ensure to:

- (i) Finalize any understanding or MoU with any other party including similar organizations abroad in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 2007 and the Statutes framed thereunder, and the instructions issued by MoE from time to time.
- (ii) Frame Rules for its corpus fund indicating clearly the IRG that can be transferred to such fund or utilized from such fund and items for which such expenditure can be incurred.
- (iii) Have clearly defined 'Delegation of Powers' for deciding all administrative and financial matters.
- (iv) Shall run courses, to the extent possible, to be self-supporting without the need for cross subsidization as well as over-charging from students for flagship courses.
- (v) Ensure that all its accounts are audited by internal auditors regularly and formal audit by the C&AG in terms of the provisions of the Act of 2007 and the Statutes framed thereunder.
- (vi) Ensure that all financial operations are done under the EAT Module of PFMS.
- (vii) Present an outcome budget along with annual action plan so that it can be dovetailed in the outcome budget of MoE
- (viii) Comply strictly with the timelines for submission of annual reports and annual audited accounts to MoE for the purpose of being tabled in Parliament within 9 months from close of the financial year.
- (ix) Forward to MoE any information required by it to satisfy any requirement related to Parliamentary Matter, RTI, Public Grievances, VIP References, Court Cases, Notices from Commissions and Statutory Authorities and also inputs for formulation of any policy.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Reservation for SCs, STs, OBCs, PwDs and EWS in Posts and Services in the Central Government

Pers Policy (Reservation) Division of the Department of Personnel and Training has issued various instructions, from time to time, regarding reservation in appointments to posts and services under the Central Government, and concessions/relaxations extended to the persons belonging to Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), Other Backward Classes (OBCs), Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) and Ex-servicemen. With a view to facilitating easy accessibility and clear understanding of these rules on reservation/concessions/relaxations, the relevant instructions on the subject (except Ex-servicemen) were last consolidated on 14/10/2022. Now, keeping in view some recent revision in the existing instructions, the consolidated instructions published on 14/10/2022 have been updated as under:

Latest DoPT Guidelines on Reservations for SCs, STs, OBCs, PwDs, and EWS

1. PROVISIONS RELATING TO SCs, STs AND OBCs

A. RESERVATION IN DIRECT RECRUITMENT AND PROMOTION

1.Reservation in Direct Recruitment (in open competition and otherwise than by open competition)

Reservation is provided to the members of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes @ 15%, 7.5% and 27%, respectively, in the matter of appointment by direct recruitment to civil posts and civil services on all India basis by open competition.

In the matter of appointment by direct recruitment to civil posts and civil services on all India basis otherwise than by open competition, reservation is provided to the members of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes @ 16.66%, 7.5% and 25.84%, respectively.

3.Exclusion of Creamy Layer from amongst OBCs:

Members of the Other Backward Classes, who fall in creamy layer, shall not get the benefit of reservation. Criterion for determining creamy layer status amongst Other Backward Classes is, as under:

ubject: Revision of quantum of reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts normally attracting candidates from a locality or a region.

The undersigned is directed to say that reservation for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts, formally attracting candidates from a locality or a region, which is generally fixed in proportion to the population of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in he respective States/UTs, was last fixed in 1985 on the basis of the 1981 Census. Reservation for Other Backward Classes in such cases was fixed in 1993 keeping in view the proportion of their population in the respective States/UTs subject to a reiling of 27% while also ensuring that the total reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs did not exceed the limit of 50% in any case. It has now been decided to revise the quantum of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts normally attracting candidates from a ocality or a region, keeping in view the figures of the 2001 Census, as given in the Annexure to this O.M.

- 2. These orders will take effect from the date of issue of this O.M. However, the cases where requisitions for filling up the posts have already been sent to the recruiting agencies or posts have already been advertised in accordance with the percentages of reservation existing prior to issue of this O.M., need not be reopened.
- 3. It is requested that contents of this O.M. may be brought to the notice of all concerned.

Subject:- Revision of quantum of reservation for Scheduled Tribes in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts normally attracting candidates from a locality or a region in the State of Goa.

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to this Department's O.M. No. 36017/1/2004-Estt.(Res.) dated 5th July, 2005 revising the quantum of reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts normally attracting candidates from a locality or a region keeping in view the figures of the 2001 Census. The quantum of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts normally attracting candidates from the regions of the State of Goa was fixed as 2%, 0% and 18% respectively. Some communities in the State of Goa have since been notified as Scheduled Tribes by the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Orders (Amendment) Act, 2002 dated 8.1.2003 after the Census 2001 was conducted. As a result of this, the proportion of population of STs in the State of Goa is now estimated at 12.07%. It has accordingly been decided to fix the quantum of reservation for STs in case of direct recruitment to Group 'C' and "D' posts normally attracting candidates from a locality or a region in the State of Goa at 12%. The entry against SI. No. 06 of Annexure to this Department's O.M. No.36017/1/2004-Estt.(Res.) dated 5th July, 2005 would, therefore, stand substituted by the following: -
