Item No. 1.3 To Note Down the Progress of the Works on which Fund has been allocated vide No. F.4-7/2004-TS.III dt. 9th July 2004.

The committee noted the progress of work made on projects for which fund has been released by the Ministry.

Item No. 1.4. Extended Demand Proposal for the year 2005-06

Item No. 1.4.1. Equipment and machineries for High -Voltage Laboratory

Resolved that the equipments for high-voltage laboratory as proposed by Electrical Engineering Department for procurement of equipment and overhead cranes, estimated to the tune of Rs. 40/- lakhs, be approved.

Item No. 1.4.2. A well equipped Married Research Scholar Hostel having a wing for Foreign Students

Resolved that a Hostel for Married Research Scholars and Foreign Students be constructed at a total cost of Rs. 550 lakhs. The committee felt that the work should be started from 2005-06 as it is observed that the Institute is not in a position to attract good number of foreign students due to lack of facilities. At the same time Institute should put all its endeavour to attract more number of foreign students and aim at reducing dependency on Government of India.

Item No., 1.4.3. Construction of an Auditorium

Resolved that construction of an Auditorium for 600 capacity with 900 Sq.M. area be approved with an estimated cost of Rs. 103 /- lakhs. Further it is resolved that construction of the Auditorium be started from the year 2005 - 06.

Item No. 1.4.4. **Laying of Hume Pipe in Kaccha Drain and Protection of two R.C. Culverts against failure due to soil erosion**

Resolved that the Institute should negotiate with C.M.E.R.I. Durgapur, so that the sewerage drain could be diverted and if required, it is advised to negotiate with local municipal body for permanent solution of this menace.

Item No. 1.4.5. **Charge for Campus Networking**

The Item is withdrawn.

Item No. 1.4.6. **Total Station and Plotter etc. for Construction Cell**

Resolved that the equipments / software as required for construction work be procured and approved Rs. 6/- lakhs for procurement of a) Total Station b) Theodolite c) A2 Plotter d) Copier etc.

Item No. 1.4.7. **Proposal for 120 seater – 3 storied Lecture Gallery**

Resolved that 120 seater – 3 storied Lecture Gallery with a capacity of 120 students in each floor be constructed. Further the committee approves the cost of construction alongwith furniture and teaching aids with a ceiling of Rs. 44 lakhs and opined that the same be built in 2005-06. A demand of Rs. 44 Lakhs be placed before the Ministry in Plan Grants of 2005-06

Item No. 1.4.8. **Proposal for Class Rooms :**

Resolved that 6 nos. – 60 seater class rooms be constructed at a cost of Rs. 27.5 lakhs out of which Rs. 3 / - lakhs shall be earmarked for furniture and teaching aid.

Item No. 1.4.9. **Proposal for a PG & RS Hostel – 300 seater**

The committee noted the views of the Institute for expanding its activities in new field of technology which are catching up with the days and appreciated its methods. It is resolved that a 6 storied single seated hostels at a cost of Rs 525 lakhs to accommodate about 350 students be constructed at the backdrop of increased in number of PG students are RS .

Item No. 1.4.10. **Proposal for 360 seater UG hostel for Boys**

Resolved that one 8 storied UG Hostel for Boys at a cost of Rs. 10 crore be constructed to accommodate increase in intake as well as students to be admitted in proposed new courses.
