SCHOLARSHIP SECTION

RULES & REGULATIONS OF INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP, 2017-2018.

INSTITUTE MERIT- CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP

1. Scholarship shall be awarded to students who are Indian Nationals admitted through CSAB/JoSSA based on the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee and subsequent approval by the Competent Authority of the Institute.
2. Scholarship is liable to be withdrawn, fully or partially, in case of misconduct, deliberate concealment of material facts and/ or supply of false information.
3. Students leaving the Institute on their own accord without completing the programme of study may be required to refund the amount of scholarship received.
4. During the tenure of availing the Institute Scholarship, the scholarship holder shall not receive any other scholarship, stipend, financial assistance or remuneration etc., from any other source except with the prior permission of the competent authority of the institute.
5. The students selected for Institute Scholarship shall not accept or hold any appointment, paid or otherwise, and will not receive any emoluments, salary, etc. from any other source during the tenure of scholarship.
6. The scholarship may be suspended or terminated at any time on the ground of misconduct on the part of the student concerned or on the ground of continued absence for more than one month (except on medical grounds) in a semester.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) The B-Tech Students who got their admission in the year 2016 and 2017 **are not** eligible for the Institute Scholarship 2017-2018.
- 2) The students belonging to the SC/ST category are not eligible for the Institute Scholarship 2017-2018.
- 3) For other eligible students (other than Clause 1 as above) :
 - a) Parental annual income not more than Rs. 1,20,000=00/- (Rupees One lakh twenty thousand only) per annum (Original of income certificate issued during the current financial year 2016-2017 i.e. on or after 01st April, 2017, by the competent issuing authority as listed in **Annexure- A** is to be submitted).
 - b) Students who have appeared for supplementary examination in any semester are not eligible for applying for Institute Scholarship.
 - c) A student against whom any action has been taken by the institute authority is not eligible for applying for Institute Scholarship.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

All application submitted by the students will be treated as fresh application. There will be no automatic renewal/ continuation of scholarship for the students who are presently availing Institute scholarship.

Selection will be made on the basis of the following points:

Parental Income.(50% weightage)

Merit (Percentage of marks obtained in the semester examinations).(50% weightage)

The applicants may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
