
Both CPWD & NBCC representatives apprised the members regarding present status of their projects.

Item No. 26.16: Raising the height of peripheral boundary wall of NIT Durgapur campus & strengthening of security aspect.



Item No. 26.17: Any other matter with the permission to the chair:


