

36.5	Air Conditioning of New Academic Block (NAB) There are 300, 150, 90 & 60 seater seminar rooms & class rooms in the NAB. Rooms are mostly utilized for classes, seminars, workshops, training & placement and examination purposes. The rooms need air-conditioning as all works get hampered during the summer season because of extreme heat & humidity. This has also been corroborated by Mr. D.S. Sachdev & Mr. A.K. Jain, Members of PMU, MHRD during their visit of the Institute on 28 th & 29 th of June, 2019 and in the subsequent meeting with the Institute Authority. CPWD has submitted a P.E. of Rs. 3,99,53,000/- for the work. The fund for the above may be utilized from the originally sanctioned amount for NAB.	The work is approved to be carried out by utilizing the balance fund of Rs. 1.89 crores available with CPWD and drawing remaining fund of Rs. 21053000.00 from the sanctioned fund of Rs. 43.49 crore vide sanction No. NITD/CPWD/2008/04 dated 19.12.2008 for NAB subject to subsequent approval of FC and BOG.
