Item No. 53.1 Confirmation of the Minutes of the 52nd Senate Meeting

The minutes of the 52nd Senate meeting were confirmed by the Senate. A typo in the Agenda note was corrected from 20th December, 2019 to 20th December, 2018.

Item No. 53.2 Action Taken Report

The Senate of the Institute noted the Action Taken Report with the following addendum.

52.7: The feedback from only the students who attended at least 60% of the classes held shall be considered for computing the data of stu7dents' feedback.

Item No. 53.3 To consider issues related to the UG and PG studies

The Senate approved/ratified the resolutions of UGAC/PGAC meetings held on 21.12.2018, 15.01.2019, 14.02.2019, 28.03.2019 and 10.05.2019 with the following amendments.

15.01.2019: Item No. 3

Reimbursement of tuition fee for eligible SC/ST students: The Institute shall comply with the directives from the MHRD (vide letter dated 14.11.2018) on the matter and submit the required information to the Ministry of

Tribal Affairs (MOTA). Chairman, Senate was requested to take up in the NIT Council the issue of reimbursement of fee waiver extended by the Institute to other students.

14.02.2019: Item No. 7

Scholarship to the backlog M.Tech. students: Resolved that the scholarship will be withheld if a student has to appear for a supplementary examination, and the scholarship will be resumed with arrears on her/his successful passing the supplementary examination. In case s/he is not able to clear the supplementary examination and gets a backlog, her/his scholarship will be terminated though s/he will continue her/his studentship without scholarship as per the norms of the PG regulation.

28.03.2019 Item No. 6

Seat Matrices for Central admissions 2019: The proposed Seat Matrix for Central admissions 2019 was ratified by the Senate.

Item No. 7

Award of degree to MSW students: The successful students shall be awarded the degree "MSW" without any mention of specialization.

Academic Calendar 2019-2020: Odd Semester 2019-20 (Sl. No. 13) Semester Registration (online) September 04-16, 2019.

Item No. 3

Dual Degree M.Tech Curricula: The B.Tech., Dual-degree M.Tech. and Integrated M.Sc. curricula (2017 and 2018) including the elective baskets were approved by the Senate with revisions as suggested by the members. Further minor corrections may be incorporated by Dean (Academic) and Chairman, Senate was empowered to approve the same.

Item No. 53.4 To consider issues related to the PhD studies

The award of PhD degree to 35 candidates and the registration of 29 candidates for the PhD program were approved (Annexure I and II). The Senate approved/ratified the minutes of the RAC meeting held on 19.12.2018, 19.02.2019, 28.03.2019, 16.04.2019 and 10.05.2019, and the recommendations of the meeting of the HoDs held on 16.01.2019 with the following amendments:

28.03.2019 Item No. 12

Seat matrix for PhD admission 2019: It was ratified by the Senate.

16.04.2019 Item No. 11

Modification of eligibility criterion for admission to PhD program (Full Time): The eligibility criteria specified in F. No. 12-2/2019-U1 dated Jan 31, 2019 as adopted in the 52nd BoG meeting shall be followed. The selection process through admission test and vivavoce conducted by NIT Durgapur shall be considered as one under Clause I(b)

10.05.2019 Item No. 7

To consider the seat matrix for admission for PhD programme 2019: The matrix was approved by the Senate. It was also resolved that the departments may submit a panel in addition to the selection list during the admission of category A PhD students in the even semester. In of vacancies in any department, selection shall be made from the panel submitted by other departments.

Item No. 8

It was resolved that "English for Technical Writing" shall omitted from the mandatory coursework requirement for the PhD students and will included as an important component in the course "Research Methodology" (3-0-2; 4 credits). IELTS/TOEFL shall be used as guidelines. Research Methodology shall also include statistical analysis, design of experiments and ethics other

than a component from the concerned department/ research area. Prof. P. Pal (Chemical Engineering) will provide inputs on plagiarism and Prof. A. B. Puri will furnish inputs to the committee to finalize the syllabus of Research Methodology. Chairman, Senate was empowered by the Senate to approve the syllabus.

Item No. 53.5 To decide the date of 15th Convocation

The date of the 15th Convocation was decided as September 07, 2019.

Item No. 53.7 To consider the reforms in the academic and examination system

The Senate approved the recommendations of the Committee with the following amendments:

- ➤ <u>UG clause 2.10</u>: If a student fails to join the Institute and attend classes within 15 days from the start of classes without any valid reason and intimation, s/he will be deemed to have left the programme. No refund of fees shall be admissible to him/her.
- ➤ <u>UG clause 7.1 and PG clause 6.1</u>: The word "undergraduate" shall be deleted.
- Fine for late submission of fees: A suitable revision shall be suggested by the committee constituted for the purpose and Chairman, Senate was empowered by the Senate to approve the same.
- ▶ UG clause 11.7: Based on the CGPA, a student shall be awarded First class Distinction, if the CGPA is 8.00 and above, subject to clearing all courses in regular examinations without disciplinary conviction. However, if a student misses the end-semester examination due to a compelling reason like serious illness of self or a calamity in the family, and has her/his absence condoned by a duly constituted committee as specified in Clause 12.3(c), s/he will be considered for First Class Distinction, in case other conditions have been fulfilled. S/he may also be considered for the award of Gold medal subject to the fulfilment of other conditions.
- ➤ <u>UG Regulations Appendix III.1.5 and PG Regulations Appendix II.1.5</u>: P grade shall be awarded for marks obtained in the range 35-49 and F grade will be awarded for marks <35. Other grades shall remain unaltered.
