NIT Durgapur has been selected as one of the Mentor Institutes under TEQIP III and was assigned the responsibility of mentoring two Institutes: i) Dumka Engineering College, Dumka, Jharkhand and ii) NIT Nagaland Mentee Institutes. Under TEQIP III, NIT Durgapur has got a sanction of Rs. 7 Crore, out of which Rs. 3.5 Crore was earmarked for procurement and rest for academic activities like students' learning, faculty & staff development, R&D, Reforms, I-I-I, Mentoring, etc. as also operating costs. NIT Durgapur further received a sanction of Rs. 3 Crore in May 2018, out of which Rs. 2.7 Crore was earmarked for continuation of activities pertaining to the Centre of Excellence on Advanced Materials while the remaining was earmarked for operating costs. Out of Rs. 2.7 Crore, Rs. 2.4 Crore was kept aside for further development of the Centre and while Rs. 0.3 Crore was sanctioned for twinning activities.

Under the procurement head, 110 Desktop Computers, 100 Laptops and all the components of studio costing around Rs. 1.38 Crores were ordered, received and is now in the installing and commissioning phase. The purchase order for XRD costing to the tune of Rs. 1.09 Crore shall shortly be placed. The balance amount of about Rs. 1 Crore for upgradation of existing the institute network including servers, switches, etc. is in the process of being procured. The actual expenditure under academic head and IOC till 31.5.19 is about Rs. 1.42 Crore.

Twinning activities with Dumka Engineering College has been expedited but the activities in regard of NIT Nagaland is not satisfactory. A meeting for review of the progress of TEQIP III was held on June 6, 2019 with the NPIU officials at New Delhi, which was subsequently followed by a meeting with the Dr. S.S. Sandhu, Additional Secretary, MHRD. It transpired during the meeting that NIT Durgapur could reach the performance benchmark in respect of expenditure (56% by June 2019 and 71% by September 2019) which was placed on record. NIT Durgapur's request for permitting at least 50% of PLA under COE was also acceded to in principle in the said meeting and the institute is now awaiting the formal communication from NPIU in this regard. NIT Nagaland also reported about their difficulties and promised to expedite the twinning activities.


the complainant. The Chairperson, ICC, National Institute of Technology Durgapur also wanted some time for further in-depth investigation.



Annexure –II

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BACKGROUND AND CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS LEADING TO THE ISSUE OF LETTER OF INTENT

Background:

- In a bid to construct a State of the art building for Management and Consultancy Centre, the National Institute of Technology Durgapur floated a Notice Inviting Tender on 05.01.05 which was advertised in **The Telegraph**.

It was suggested that Institute should go for pre-qualification bids and asked the intended tenderers for submission of their expression of interest along with conceptual drawing accommodating our requirements specified in tender documents. The last date of receipt of pre-qualification bids was 12 noon of 28.01.05. In response to our advertisement, the Institute received 10 number of bids and all were evaluated on the same date at 15 hrs as notified by the Committee. The Committee after going through all the credentials, and the conceptual drawing, selected three parties, viz (i) M/S CIV TECT(I) Pvt. Ltd. (Sl.No.3/10) (ii) M/S NPCC Ltd (Sl.No.6/10) (iii) M/S G.R.S. Construction (Sl.No.9/10).

The Committee decided that the three parties as mentioned above, asked to submit their commercial bids, based on conceptual drawing supplied by the individual firm. The documents was then forwarded to the undersigned for comments.

It appears from records that the above three parties fulfilled the requirement and virtually competent to execute the work. All of them have the required man power, machineries and financial resources. The undersigned, after going through all the records including credential of all the parties, suggest that the commercial bids be restricted between M/S CIV TEC(I) Pvt. Ltd. 73/29 Gold Club Road, Kolkata and M/S G.R.S. Construction, Hindusthan Road, Kolkata and M/S NPCC may not be allowed to participate on the following grounds.(as assessed from their past performance at REC, DGP/NIT DGP)

Time is the essence of contract and M/S NPCC failed to adhere to.

- (1) Delay in completion of Store Shed
- (2) Delay in completion of Lab. Sheds
- (3) Delay in completion 120 seater boys hostel
- (4) Delay in completion of works leads to block up huge capital and non utilisation of buildings.
- (5) Time and again deviation made for which timely permission/approval had not been obtained.
- (6) Man Power and Machine Powers were not fully utilised even though they had required number, which caused abnormal delay in completion of works.
- (7) Even though payments towards running bills were made in time i.e. within 30 days on submission of bill, but sub contractors were not paid their dues in time for which the institute had to face problem.
- (8) Performance is very poor as may be seen that newly constructed Ladies Hostel, where water remained stagnant in the bath rooms.
- (9) Technical knowledge of the construction work is not upto the mark, as may be seen that kitchen of newly constructed Ladies Hostel where outlet provided is not enough.
- (10) Similarly 120 seater boys hostel kitchen also constructed defectively and no alternate suggestion were made by them.

In view of the above lapses of work on the part of the M/S NPCC, the other two bidders may be considered for competing in the commercial bid.

With reference to the above mentioned subject, attention is drawn on the following fact.

After conversion from R.E. College to National Institute of Technology, NIT Durgapur could not conduct Departmental Promotion of Non-teaching staff members for about fifteen years for various reason. After introduction of new Recruitment Rules-2019, it has come to the notice that the scope of promotion has been reduced due to distribution of posts in the Ratio of 4:3:2:1 which has been specified under Sl. No.4.B (i) in Recruitment Rules (RRs)-2019. Consequently a trifle number of existing employees may be promoted.

Further, it has come to the notice in Recruitment Rules- 2014 & 2017, the Ratio of Promotion for upper posts was not mentioned there and due to that reason the eligible candidates (i.e. who fulfils the educational qualifications, experience and other criteria as per RRs-2014 & 2017) may be promoted in all cadres.

In view of the above, to consider the appeal for one time relaxation in distribution of posts for promotion in the upper posts, so that, the eligible candidates who fulfils the educational qualifications, experience and other criteria as per RRs-2019 and who have not awarded promotion for a long times due to non-conduction of Departmental Promotion may be considered for promotion for one time measure.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Master Circular for infrastructure projects in centrally funded institutions.

With a view to ensure timely completion of the infrastructure projects in centrally funded institutions and to avoid time/cost escalations due to systematic failures & other generic factors, Government has been issuing guidelines/circulars from time to time. This is a master circular brings together such guidelines/circulars.

2. The commonly found issues in the projects being implemented in the CFIs have been (i) Faulty preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) (ii) taking sanctions (for DPRs prepared) without availability of the land (iii) absence of planning for phase-wise construction (iv) taking up works which are not in the DPRs (v) extravagant construction, not provided for in the sanctioned project (vi) absence of norms and standards for construction especially on the per student area (vii) release of block grants without linking to progress of works, allowing new works sanctioned which are not part of the original sanction (viii) change of specifications and designs midway, especially when the head of institution changes (ix) conflicts between the architects appointed by the institution and the construction agency selected by the PMC (x) non-payment of the bills in time, either due to non-availability of funds in time; or holding back bills due to disputes. Unless these issues are addressed systematically, there cannot be timely completion of quality infrastructure projects without cost and time overrun in CFIs.

3. In order to address these issues henceforth, the following instructions are issued for compliance by all CFIs in all their infrastructure projects funded by Government.

A. Sanction of a new institution:

1. When a new institution has been announced, the sanction to be taken shall be limited for running the institution in the temporary campus.
2. For construction of permanent campus, there shall be a detailed DPR prepared, based on the site conditions and as per specifications as laid down.

B. Selection of site:

1. State/UT will be asked to offer few sites suitable for construction of institution which are free from all encumbrances.
2. The land offered shall satisfy the following:
 - a. Should be well-drained and not waterlogged.
 - b. Shall not be flood prone
 - c. Shall not have steep fall / unbuildable hilly terrain or low weight bearing capacity of the soil
 - d. Shall have soil quality that allows construction with normal foundations.
 - e. The site should not be more than 50 kms away from airport/railway station
 - f. Should be easily approachable.
 - g. Sufficient infrastructures like schools / hospitals/ markets etc should be available near to the site
 - h. There shall be possibility of finding employment for the spouses of faculty.

Finally, the site shall be able to attract and retain high quality faculty.

3. Once sites for establishment of permanent campus have been identified and offered by the State Government concerned, Ministry of HRD will constitute a Site Selection Committee which would evaluate the suitability of the land as per above factors. They shall also get report from the flood control / Irrigation Department of the State, Geo-technical expert in hilly terrain and soil investigation report respectively, to satisfy itself about the suitability of the land for construction before they recommend a particular site for establishment of permanent campus.

C. Preparation of DPR

1. DPR shall be prepared only after the land for the permanent campus is handed over by the State Govt concerned. DPRs prepared without a detailed study of the land shall be treated as invalid.
2. Only agencies who have in-house competence shall be identified for DPR preparation. It is advised to use the in-house team of CPWD for this purpose.
3. If there is a large land, development has to be done preferably in compact blocks of 50 Acres.
4. The DPR shall be prepared only for the first phase of development.
5. For preparing the DPR, taking the following data from the land would be mandatory:
 - a. Soil samples and load bearing strength of soil to decide on the type of foundations.
 - b. Specifications:
 - i. Number of students shall not be more than projected in the original approval.
 - ii. The total area planned per student shall not be more than 75 Sq mts.
 - iii. Within the given area: Labs, Academic facilities, hostels and administrative block (which shall be an iconic building) shall be planned first.

- iv. All buildings shall be green buildings as specified in the code.
6. The broad guidelines for appraisal of infrastructure works will be as enclosed at **Annexure A**. In addition, other CPWD norms/guidelines for construction related works should also be followed scrupulously.

D. APPRAISAL OF THE PROJECT:-

1. Appraisal & approval of the project based on the approved DPR shall be done through SFC/EFC/Cabinet as per the extant instructions of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.
2. Any further extension of the campus beyond approved DPR, including increase in number of students, programmes, buildings, etc will not be considered till the complete establishment of the permanent campus as per approved DPR and till it comes out of project mode.
3. The Ministry will also ensure that no funds for construction related works shall be released to the Institute before finalization & approval of site specific DPR.

E. Execution only through EPC mode:

1. The only mode of construction shall be through EPC mode.
2. The OM No.N-14070/14/2016-PPPAU dated 05.09.2016 of NITI Ayog, in pursuance of the decisions taken by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), emphasizes the need to substitute the Item-rate Contracts with EPC contracts wherever appropriate. The Works Division of the Ministry of Urban Development vide OM No.28012/11/2016-W.3 dated 29.11.2016 has directed that all works with value of more than Rs.100 crore shall be taken up only under EPC contracts. The circular also directed CPWD, NBCC and DDA to advise all client organizations to adhere to the instructions issued by NITI Aayog and that they need not engage outside design/structural consultants as the same would be part of EPC tender. The directions of Government in the matter are unambiguous and consistent.
3. The OM No. DG/MAN/Misc./26 dated 24.05.2019 (**Annexure-B**) has clarified that the EPC contracts can be adopted in the three modes, details of which are outlined in Para-1 of the aforementioned OM. EPC mode of contracts can be adopted even where institutes have engaged architectural consultants and where the value of works is less than Rs.100 Crore.
4. In the EPC mode, the institutes would decide the detailed specifications, and later allow the EPC contractor to execute works as per specifications. Further, the institute would be able to monitor the progress from time to time, and impose penalties for delays in execution. There will be quality control through 3rd party Quality Assurance Agency.

F. Role of Institution bodies like BWC/FC/BoG

1. Building and Works Committee of the Institute has a very important role to play, as all construction proposals are initiated by this expert Committee. If proper due-diligence is done by the Building and Works Committee before approving construction



proposals, most of the mistakes which happen later on, can be avoided.

2. Building and Works Committees shall have independent experts, if necessary as special invitees, from all the streams of constructions represented in it (i.e., civil engineering, electrical engineering, public health engineering, architects, master planner, horticulture/ forestry experts, landscape experts, rain water harvesting experts, etc) related to various fields of construction who shall examine the proposals in accordance with the principles laid down in this Circular.


3. Building and Works Committee should ensure "value architecture" and "value engineering", with a view to economize the construction by avoiding unnecessary high cost options, without compromising on quality.

4. Building and Works Committee will also keep in view the provisions of the approved DPR as far as sanctions under different heads are concerned before considering and recommending the construction proposals to the Finance Committee.

G. Responsibility of the Director/Head of the institution/MHRD

1. It will be the responsibility of the Director or head of the institution to ensure that the no construction proposals which are NOT part of the approved DPR (or project in case of independent works) are proposed or placed before the BWC or FC.
2. The provisioning shall be as per the financial provisions as approved by the competent authority in the DPR.
3. The amount of the proposal should not be higher than the provisions of the DPR under a particular head.
4. The agenda items of the Finance Committee should very clearly mention that the building(s) proposed are part of the DPR approved by the Competent Authority.
5. The proposal for a building shall not be more than the amount approved in the DPR.
6. It is the duty of the Director of the Institute concerned to ensure that all agenda items put up for consideration of the FC/ BOG have thoroughly been examined at the Institute level. The agenda items may be put up along with the justification and recommendations so as to facilitate the members of the FC/ BOG to take a considered view.
7. Every member of the Finance Committee and BoG, including the representatives of MHRD and IFD, will go through the agenda items carefully. It will be the individual and collective responsibility of all the members of the FC and BoG to ensure that construction proposals under different heads don't exceed the amount sanctioned in the DPR under that particular head.
8. Member Secretary of BoG and Director/ VC of the Institute will ensure that every agenda item which has some financial implication, including construction proposals, first go to FC and only with FC's recommendations they are considered by BoG.
9. Once the construction starts, mid-way change in design etc. are not permitted, without specific approval of Government.

10. Institute shall monitor the quality of construction through 3rd party Quality Assurance Agency.
 11. The members of Project Monitoring Unit constituted by MHRD shall make regular inspections to the site to oversee/monitor the infrastructure works and will make recommendations to MHRD so that above guidelines are strictly complied with.
 12. The progress of construction shall be monitored monthly at the institute level and also at the Ministry level through the Project Monitoring Software portal during the execution phase.
4. As the Director is the Chief Executive Officer of the Institute, it is his primary responsibility to ensure the compliance of the above guidelines, norms and financial ceilings fixed for the project.
 5. The above guidelines may be circulated to all concerned for information, adoption and strict compliance.

Sub: Broad guidelines for appraisal of Infrastructure projects in CFIs

The following would be the broad guidelines for appraisal of infrastructure projects for CFIs. These guidelines would be used for appraisal of all new projects which would be posed to the Ministry for appraisal.

- (i) Only the works in the priority list (Annexure-I) would be funded. In case any additional area is to be constructed, the same has to be adequately justified.
- (ii) The works in the negative list (Annexure-II) would not be funded. If any work under these categories are already sanctioned/ started, no further funding shall be released on these works, except that which is needed to bring the work to safe stage and close. Of course, the institution can mobilise funds from other sources for their completion.
- (iii) The infrastructure entitlements will be for the student strength as per the sanctioned project.
- (iv) In the new institutions, the land shall be developed in parcels of 50 Acres each, with utilities like roads, sewage garbage disposal system, water facilities etc. Only after full utilisation of this 50 acres, can another parcel of 50 acres be started for land development. The development shall therefore be confined to that part of the land (only) which is functionally required to serve the student strength for the next 5 years.

4. Smart Classrooms:

All Classrooms shall be smart classroom as per the specifications of the ODB Expert committee.

5. Self sustained projects:

Projects which are able to mobilise funds for their construction and maintenance, like research parks.

1. Any work in excess of the limits prescribed in the Priority list.
2. Swimming Pools.
3. Shopping Complexes.
4. Eatery/Food Courts

8. Construction of Director/ Faculty/ Staff quarters in excess to the entitlement as per CPWD norms.
9. Guest House with more than (20) Rooms.

Subject:- Mode of Execution of EPC Contracts.

As per provision contained in para 4.8 of CPWD Works Manual 2019 it is made mandatory that tenders for works costing more than Rs. 100 Crores shall be called in EPC mode. There are instances wherein clients wish to adopt EPC contract document where drawings are already finalized. Therefore, to resolve the difficulties of adoption of EPC, the following guidelines are issued in respect of execution of works on EPC mode:-

Mode I: In this case, the Engineering, Procurement and Construction would be fully contracted. However, the conceptual drawings shall be prepared by the CPWD Architects.

Mode II: In this case, the architectural planning would be done by the CPWD Architects/Architects appointed by Clients. The EPC Contractor will carry out Engineering, Procurement and Construction based on the architectural planning by the department.

Mode III: In this case, the architectural designs, drawings and engineering will be done in house by CPWD or the Consultant appointed by Client/CPWD, the work would be executed by EPC Contractor.

As per requirement of the Client, the works on EPC mode in any of the above modes can be taken up for the works costing more than Rs. 100 Crores. However, in case Client wants to adopt EPC mode for the works costing less than Rs. 100 Crores, the NIT approving authorities are authorized to adopt the same out of any of the modes mentioned above.

However it is clarified that Mode-I mentioned above will remain the preferred way of execution of works through EPC Contracts.



Sir \ Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Order of even number dated 15th May, 2018 vide which an Oversight Committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of Prof. Sivaji Chakravorti, Director, National Institute of Technology, Calicut (Kerala) to look into further issues / anomalies, which are not yet covered / addressed in the revised Recruitment Rules (RRs) notified for Faculty on 24th July, 2017 and issued on 20th December, 2017 for Non-Faculty staff of the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) and Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IEST), Shibpur (West Bengal).

2. At the same time, the Directors of all the NITs and IEST, Shibpur were requested to forward the left out anomalies / issues in the RR to the Chairman of the Oversight Committee. Accordingly, the Oversight Committee received suggestions / representation from various NITs and IEST, Shibpur. The Oversight Committee has looked into the issues / anomalies, which are not yet covered / addressed in the revised Recruitment Rules of Faculty and Non-Faculty staff and has submitted its reports in respect of faculty of NITs and IEST, Shibpur on 27th October, 2018.

3. The observations pointed out by this Ministry were further discussed in the Oversight Committee meeting held on 19th January, 2019. The recommendations submitted by the Oversight Committee on 27th October, 2018 and 19th January, 2019, respectively, have been examined in this Ministry. The recommendations of the Oversight Committee are divided into two categories viz. (i) clarifications on existing RRs and (ii) amendments in RRs notified on 24th July, 2017. With the approval of the competent authority it has been decided
