Online Applications are invited for **ONE** post of **Junior Research Fellow (JRF)** under Department of Higher Education, Science & Technology and Biotechnology, Govt. of West Bengal sponsored research project titled “Emerging Contaminants and their accumulation in ecosystem of lower stretch of Hooghly River” The staff will be appointed initially for six months (**purely on temporary basis**) and the services may be extended till the end of the project based on the performance review.

Minimum Qualification: B.Tech/BE (7.5 CGPA or 70% marks for General/OBC and 7.0 CGPA or 65% marks for SC/ST) in Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Environmental Engineering; M.Tech/ME (6.5 CGPA or 60% marks for General/OBC and 6.0 CGPA or 55% marks for SC/ST) in Environmental Engineering/ Environmental Science and Technology/ Engineering, Water Resource Engineering, Agricultural Engineering; MSc (6.5 CGPA or 60% marks for General/OBC and 6.0 CGPA or 55% marks for SC/ST) in Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology/Earth Science/Applied Geology/Geochemistry / Hydrogeology (or Groundwater) /Agriculture from any recognized Institute/ University.

Fellowship*: Rs. 18,000/- for JRF and Rs. 21000/- for SRF
