PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF E-TENDER

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bid electronically on the ITI e-Wizard Portal using valid Digital Signature Certificates. Below mentioned instructions are meant to guide the bidders for registration on the e-Wizard Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submit their bids online on the ITI e-Wizard Portal. 1. REGISTRATION PROCESS ON ONLINE PORTAL

- a. Bidders to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the portal https://mhrd.euniwizarde.com by clicking on the link "Bidder Enrolment" as per portal norms.
- b. The bidders to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the e-Wizard Portal.
