If you're new to the game of basketball, you've probably wondered what the deal is with all the signals from the referees. For a newcomer to basketball, it may seem as if officials have their own unique sign language. This can create a very confusing experience if you don't understand the signals. Have you ever wondered what referees are reporting during a basketball game? Read on to know the breakdown of each referee's signal and the meaning of each. Breaking Down Every Referee Signal Violation Signals Travel (Walk) What it means: When the ball manager takes too many steps without dribbling the basketball, the referee whistles and calls a roving breach. This will result in the loss of possession of the ball by the offensive team (turnover). The driving signal is made by the referee making a rolling/rotating motion with both arms. Five Seconds to do so. If the entry lasts longer than five seconds, the referee whistles. He will then lean five fingers to report the breach call for five seconds. Double dribbling or illegal What it means: When the handler swings with both hands at the same time, it is a double dribbling and will result in a turnover for the attack. A double dribbling also occurs when the ball handler takes the dribbling but then tries to dribble again later. The referee's signal for illegal dribbling is to make a dribbling move with both hands. Ten Seconds Violation What it means: After a team enters the ball, they are given ten seconds to pass the ball midfield. If it takes more than 10 seconds, the referee will destroy the game and call a 10-second breach. Palming) the ball What it means: This is not called much by college basketball or NBA officials, but is called a little during children's games. Transport takes place when the ball handler or palm the ball or tries to scoop under it means: When an offensive player kicks the ball on purpose, the game is blown and the referee assigns possession to the defence allowing them to throw it out of bounds. To call a kick violation, the officer simply kicks one foot. Over and Back (Half Court or Backcourt Violation) What it means: Once the attacking team crosses the midcourt line, they can no longer cross it. If they do, the referee will whistle and call a back-and-forth violation. This will result in a loss of possession for the offensive team. Three seconds, the show is over. all done. The offense must give up the possession of the ball. To make the signal for a three-second violation, the referee will put three fingers on both hands and keep a high arm and a low arm. Signals Fouls check by hand what it means: when a defender limits an offensive player with his hand, a hand call check is performed by the official. The signal is an open hand in the air while the other hand grabs the wrist. Charge what it means: when the ball manager scrolls on a defender who set his feet and established the position, the referee will call a refill foul. This will result in a turnover and re-count as a personal foul to the offensive player. Contepters also against the number of team fouls and could cause free throws if the team is beyond the limit. To make the charge call, the official simply puts your hand on your hand and protrudes the elbow. Keeping what it means: a defender cannot contain an offensive player. Block what means: when a defensive player is in the way of the path of the ball manager towards the trash without putting his feet, he can be called a blocking foul. If a blocking foul is called, the ball manager will receive free throws if his team is in the bonus. If the team is not in the bonus, the ball will be taken out of the limits from the lateral line. To make the blocking call, the official will put both hands on the hips. Technical Foul What it means: Technical Fouls are usually issued for an anti-supported conduct. The technical fouls are also invited to players who are fighting on the Court. To report a technical foul, the REF simply has a t with its hands, similar to a timeout signal. When a technical foul is called, the opposing team is assigned with a free throw attempt and possession of the ball. Start Clock What it means: When the official is ready to start the clock, he raises one hand up and then lower it rapidly. Stop Clock What it means: To let the player's table know that a player has tried a three-point shot, the official will hold three fingers. Three Points Score What it means: When a player hits a three point, the ref will raise both hands to signal that it was a successful three point shot.
