38.4	CPWD [vide letter no. 54(8) SE/Durgapur/CPWD/2020/61, dt. 21.02.2020] (Annexure 38.2) has made a demand for Rs.1.22 cr. beyond the sanctioned amount of Rs.26.78 cr. for completion of the project. The additional fund is necessary for :
	 I. Introduction of GST from 1st July, 2017. II. Installation of projector of minimum 20000 lumens (as recommended by PMU team) as against 12000 lumens originally considered. III. Podium fitted with touch screen for Wacom & on screen writing facility with digital pen, feed to be connected to the projector. IV. Document camera. V. 90"LED TVs (2 nos.) inside the auditorium for facilitating better view for the audience at the back. VI. Movable lift (2 nos.) for PWD & wheelchair bound people, for access to stage.

The proposal was accepted in principle in connection with Diamond Jubilee Celebrations of the Institute (# 37.11). Understanding the urgency of the project for the students, the work is now proposed to be taken under EWS. CPWD has submitted a P.E. of Rs. 6,49,82,000/- i/c Contingencies (Annexure - 38.5).Placed for consideration of the project under **EWS** and approval of the Item No. Expansion & refurbishing of laboratories, academic departments & 38.8 classrooms. The proposal was accepted in principle (# 37.12) under **EWS** scheme. The P.E. submitted by CPWD was found to be not in order & was to be resubmitted by them. CPWD has submitted a P.E. of Rs.8,04,89,368/- i/c Contingencies (Annexure - 38.6) for a no. of components. Understanding that there is a requirement of networking facility to be provided, so the components of the above work may be taken up on a priority basis & a sum of Rs. 2.00 cr. Is proposed to be kept for networking facilities. Placed for approval of the P.E. Construction of Vertical Extension of the IT building (previous Item No. 38.9 Administrative building) The Institute is suffering from an acute crunch in space for academic & research activities and faculty office in view of a large increase in the faculty strength and elective courses offered to the students. The IT building (previous Administrative building) that presently houses Mathematics and CSE departments, was constructed by MECON (in 2002 - 2003) with three floors with a foundation for five floors for future expansion. It is proposed to construct two additional floors (vertical extension) in the building for academic and research activities. It is proposed to complete these works from the **EWS** scheme. The P.E. of Rs 4,63,59,000/- has been submitted by CPWD (Annexure -38.7).. Placed for approval of the project and the P.E. Completion of the top two floors of Sarojini Naidu Hall of Residence Item No. 38.10 including the interiors

Sarojini Naidu Hall of Residence (Hall 13) was handed over by CPWD and inaugurated in July 2017. The construction of the hostel was made for seven floors but the interiors were completed for five floors only and

handed over to the Institute as the fund allocated was fully spent for students' accommodation.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the hostel accommodation will need a rethink towards reducing the congestion and will require an urgent expansion of hostel capacity for the girl students. The top two incomplete floors of Hall 13 have been lying unutilized for the last three years for want of funds. These floors are already constructed and will only need the remaining works like flooring, toilets, plastering and other interiors. It is proposed to complete these works from the **EWS** scheme.

The P.E. of Rs 2,22,69,500/- has been submitted by CPWD (**Annexure – 38.8**).

Item No. 38.11

Extension of sewer line including toilet blocks at NIT Campus,

Relaying & renovation of sewer lines of the academic block (old & new), library, S. N. Ray Memorial building & the building opposite to it, 1500 capacity auditorium were not considered in the earlier scope. But for better management of sewer lines all over the campus, the abovementioned zones may be considered to be connected to the newly laid sewer lines in the campus along with construction of a few toilet blocks in selected points in the campus.

The proposal was earlier discussed & accepted in principle (# 37.21). It is proposed to complete these works from the **EWS** scheme under renovation of academic departments for the enhanced intake of students.

The P.E. of Rs 2,74,21,000/-has been submitted by CPWD (Annexure – **38.9**).

Sub: Requirement of additional funds for Construction of 1500 seated Auditorium at NIT Durgapur. Sir,

The A/A & E/S amount of the above said work is Rs. 26.78 crore vide letter no. Nil dtd 23.12.2011. Tenders were called in two packages. Only building works were in the first package which have been completed in Nov. 2018 and total cost is Rs. 18.95 crores. Second tender was called for services such as AC, Acoustics, Audio-Video, chair, stage-crafting, stage lighting, false ceiling etc. for which tender amount is Rs. 6 crore and total cost is likely to be 8.60 crore.

Thus total expenditure for this work shall be Rs.28 crores which is 1.22 crore above the sanction amount Rs. 26.78 crore.

Main reasons of deviation of cost are as follows:-

- (i) In the tender of 2nd package the provision of projector of 12000 lumens was considered as a part of Audio-Video system. The rate of projector in tender was Rs. 17 lacs. Later PMU team on their visit in June 2019 pointed out that Projector of 12000 lumens is sufficient for this auditorium and they recommended the projector of minimum 20000 lumens. Accordingly the tender for projector has been called and the tentative cost is likely to be Rs. 45 lacs.
- (ii) Because of GST introduced on 1st July 2017 there has been an extra expenditure in 1st package, items paid on market rates and in 2nd package tender rates have also been high due to this.
- (iii) Initially there were many Electrical cables and telephone cables passing through the site which were shifted. There was also a big drain passing through the site which has been diverted. The diversion of these works took extra cost.

In this way, as explained above total cost of the project has exceeded the sanctioned amount Rs. 26.78 crore by Rs.1.22 crores which is within 10% of the sanctioned amount for which sanction revised estimate is not required.

So, it is requested that the said amount Rs. 1.22 crore beyond the sanctioned amount may be released so that the final bills of agency may be cleared please.

- 5. Periodical monitoring with all stakeholders for coordination- fortnightly
- 6. Slippages to be identified and corrective action decided timely for compliance

7. Special focus on Quality, Time and Cost- all stakeholders.

- 8. Workers' training at site for skilled jobs- masonry, carpentry, electrical etc
- 9. Safety of construction workers to be ensured at site alongwith their hygienic living condition
- 10. Conducting workshops at site on regular intervals- quality, specifications, good engineering practices to be shared
- 11. 'Third Party Quality Assurance' (TPQA) team to inspect construction on regular intervals and submit findings to PMC and the Institute- No Tolerance for bad work
- 12. Simultaneous action by Institutes for furniture- class room, labs, hostels, library, dining, kitchen equipments, security- it will avoid delay in occupation of buildings

POST CONSTRUCTION PHASE

1. List of defects to be made jointly at the time of Handing/Taking over of buildings and timeframe for attending to the defects to be drawn up. To be closely monitored

2. Suitable 'Defect Liability Period (DLP)' to be included in contract/agreement

Operation and Maintenance also to be included in the original contract for hassle free services from original equipment provider- air-conditioning, sub-stations, DG sets, pumps, STP, electrical systems, CCTV, external lighting, security related equipments etc
