This Preliminary Estimate framed by Er.Manish Kumar Kanodia, Executive Engineer, NIT Durgapur Division, CPWD, Durgapur and Er. R.N.Kundu, Executive Engineer (E), Durgapur Electrical Division, CPWD, Durgapur of the Probable cost of Rs. 4,63,59,000/-(Rupees Four Crore Sixty Three Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand) only including 3% Contingencies.

### REPORT

### HISTORY:

This Preliminary estimate amounting to Rs. 4,63,59,000/-(Rupees Four Crore Sixty Three Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand) only i/c 3% Contingencies, & 1% WB Govt. Contractor Labour Welfare Cess has been framed to cover the probable cost of the above work and accord necessary A/A & E/S of the competent authority.

This estimate has been prepared based on the proposal for Vertical Extension of Old Academic Building (Originally planned as IT Building) at NIT Durgapur (WB)as asked via mail given by prof. Soumya Bhattacharyya dated 02.09.2020 that the present G+2 Structure has been designed for Six storied building and NIT wants Vertical extension by two additional floors. Also General arrangement and structural drawings for the building were given, accordingly the provision of vertical extension by two floors was found feasible as per approved structural drawings. Plinth area of the required vertical extension over existing G+2 RCC Framed structure was found to be 502.5 sqm x 2 = 1005 sqm.

Accordingly this Preliminary estimate has been prepared amounting to Rs. 4,63.59,000/-(Rupees Four Crore Sixty Three Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand) only i/c 3% Contingencies, 1% Contract Labour Welfare Cess as per West Bengal Principal Secretary (W.B) No- 107(40) Pr/Sec dated. 17.01.2007.

#### **DESIGN AND SCOPE:**

The following provisions have been kept in this estimate for building portion-

- 1) Services (Civil)
- a) Vertical extension of 2 additional floor overexisting G+2 RCC Frame Structure
- b) Integral cement based water proofing treatment at roof.
- c) Internal water supply and sanitary installation foe additional two floors.

### 2) Services (Electrical)

- a) Internal electric installation for proposed two floors
- b) Power wiring and plugs for proposed 2 floors
- c) Lightning conductors
- d) LAN conduit & cabling for proposed 2 floors
- e) Firefighting system with hose reel, down comer system, terrace tank and pump for all floors. (Note: - Existing small shaft (for 5 person lift) as shown in the drawing will be used as Firefighting Down comer Shaft)
- g) Automatic Fire Alarm System for all floors.
- h) 8 passenger Lift- 1 no. (As per availability of existing shaft in the building which is shown in the drawing, 13 passenger lift is not possible for installation. Note:- In actual Site visit shaft was found covered and CPWD has considered the provision for lift as per the drawings given by NIT Authorities)
- (i) Electrical Supply Distribution panel for the Entire building after replacing the existing one.
- (i) Split AC -20 no. 1.5 TR & 20 No. 2.0 TR for the top two floors

SPECIFICATIONS: The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specification 2010(Reprint), Vol I & Vol -II in general with up to date correction slip.

LAND: Available.

RATE: Based on DPAR 2019 duly enhanced by @ 6% to account for the present approved Cost Index.

Sir,

The A/A & E/S amount of the above said work is Rs. 26.78 crore vide letter no. Nil dtd 23.12.2011. Tenders were called in two packages. Only building works were in the first package which have been completed in Nov. 2018 and total cost is Rs. 18.95 crores. Second tender was called for services such as AC, Acoustics, Audio-Video, chair, stage-crafting, stage lighting, false ceiling etc. for which tender amount is Rs. 6 crore and total cost is likely to be 8.60 crore.

Thus total expenditure for this work shall be Rs.28 crores which is 1.22 crore above the sanction amount Rs. 26.78 crore.

Main reasons of deviation of cost are as follows:-

- In the tender of 2<sup>nd</sup> package the provision of projector of 12000 lumens was considered as a part (i) of Audio-Video system. The rate of projector in tender was Rs. 17 lacs. Later PMU team on their visit in June 2019 pointed out that Projector of 12000 lumens is sufficient for this auditorium and they recommended the projector of minimum 20000 lumens. Accordingly the tender for projector has been called and the tentative cost is likely to be Rs. 45 lacs.
- Because of GST introduced on 1st July 2017 there has been an extra expenditure in 1st package, (ii)items paid on market rates and in 2<sup>nd</sup> package tender rates have also been high due to this.
- Initially there were many Electrical cables and telephone cables passing through the site which (iii)were shifted. There was also a big drain passing through the site which has been diverted. The diversion of these works took extra cost.

In this way, as explained above total cost of the project has exceeded the sanctioned amount Rs. 26.78 crore by Rs.1.22 crores which is within 10% of the sanctioned amount for which sanction revised estimate is not required.

So, it is requested that the said amount Rs. 1.22 crore beyond the sanctioned amount may be released so that the final bills of agency may be cleared please.


