52.01 To confirm the Minutes of the 51st Meeting of the Finance Committee held on March 18, 2021.

The Annual Budget Allocation to NIT Durgapur for the Financial Year 2021 – 22 by MoEdu was placed before the Finance Committee. It was informed that the allocation made under OH-35 can exclusively be used for activities related to EWS scheme.
